# What do you see as the main challenges with the merger?

# What do you see as the main challenges with the merger?

Less time to discuss important topics, less intimate group feeling

We need to maintain the good sense of having close colleagues in sister countries

Loose hands on discussions, get stuck to policy level and never ending visions.

Too many participants – people will split into groups with the ones they know or work together

Travel costs for 2, 3 participants from the school. Raise in level of formality and it will influence the trust/openess level.

That not all Irc's will have the courage to speak

Only 1 participant coming (financial pressure) and it is not IRC

Relevant content for all participants

To keep the warm and relaxed atmosphere that we have among IRCs!



# What do you see as the main challenges with the merger?

A risk of becoming too abstract

The merge is important. IRC can meet also separately within.

Loss of family feeling

Make the rectors be active

That the meeting will be on the rectors terms. Strategy and direction is important, but discussions about our daily work situation is also very important
