### SHORT SUMMARY OF THE PROJECT

NORD+MIX is a trans-disciplinary intensive hands-on workshop aimed at learning how to create, develop and perform music compositions in an ambisonic environment. Emphasis is on innovative music technology, tools and methodology developed at the Music Innovation Studies Centre (MiSC) of the LMTA.

### MAIN BENEFITS / OUTCOMES OF THE PROJECT

1. Twenty-six students have learned about sound sphere, and have created, developed and performed ambisonic compositions during practical, hands-on workshops.
