Examples of synergies N+ E+

- ▶ NOMAZZ

- ▶ Originally created in Nordplus as Joint Study Program
- ▶ Supported by NordPULS – express mobilities
- ▶ Erasmus for long term student exchange

- ▶ ACT IN ART

- ▶ Started as a Nordic development project
- ▶ Then separate network
- ▶ Then RENEW (KA2) ->AEC Entrepreneurship Focus
- ▶ Now back to ANMA and NEXT! – Artistic Citizenship

- ▶ NEXT MOVE – music&movement

- ▶ Created as a KA2 project – intellectual outcome: Joint Module – SE, DK, NL
- ▶ Now supported by short term mobility N+
