STUDENT MOBILITY

Long term

- 3-12 months
- NB! Networks are encouraged to use other funding sources, e.g. Erasmus+

Short term

• 1-2 months

Express

- 1 week (5 days) to 1 month
- Can be used to invite students from partner instutions



Possible after at least one year of studies (except Express)

PhD not eligible

ECTS used

Studies/placement fully recognized at home institution

Teacher mobility

- Minimum 8 working hours
- Teaching, tutoring, development of teaching material etc.

- 5-week student mobility: 200 € + 70 € = 270 € + travel
 grant
- 8-day teacher mobility: 355 € + 70 € + travel grant
- 1-day teacher mobility: 70 € + travel grant

PROJECTS

Intensive courses

- 1 week 1 month
- Students and staff from at least three countries
- Recommended to rotate the host institution

Development projects

- Joint curriculum planning, joint modules, quality assurance, development of teaching methods, dissemination of project resultsetc.
- Can include only teachers
- Not time limited
