

GOAL 8 GOOD JOBS AND ECONOMIC GROWTH




TARGET 8.4 DECOUPLING

HOW ARE WE DOING? 2020





SHIFTING FROM SUSTAINABLE TO REGENERATIVE


Regenerative culture (Wahl, 2022):


